

Manicure and U.V. gel polish Home care recommendations

REMOVAL OF U.V. GEL POLISH AT HOME

1. Lightly file the shiny layer of the UV gel polish with a white block (to allow the acetone to penetrate and lift it off).
2. Tear open the **fast foil** pouch (single-dose aluminum pouch pre-soaked with acetone), insert the finger into the pouch (acetone pad on the nail), close around the finger, and cover with a heat source.
ex. magic bag (7 to 10 minutes).
3. Remove the fast foil pouch and scrape off the gel using a cuticle pusher spoon.



MOISTURIZING HAND TREATMENT

A moisturizing treatment rich in nutrients that deeply penetrates the skin for maximum hydration and softness. An excellent product to use at home between hand treatments. Helps treat chapped skin and dry or rough patches.

Apply the glove, leave on for 20 minutes, then massage the remaining lotion into the skin for a soothing hand treatment.
